
## **Steel Chest And Cabinet Manual**




# NECESSARY TOOLS REQUIRED FOR ASSEMBLY

- 10mm socket(for cabinet side handles)
- · 14mm socket
- · Extension ratchet

## FIRST

#### **INSTALL HANDLES**


Simply position the handles over the holes and attach with the bolts provided. Tighten securely.



### SECOND

#### **INSTALL THE CASTERS**


Carefully lay bottom cabinet on its back using a soft mat under the back for protection. Position the two swivel casters on the bottom of the cabinet, on the right side (same side as the handle). Insert M8x25 bolts through washers, then through the casters and into the bottom of the cabinet. Tighten securely using a 14mm socket. Repeat for the two rigid casters on the other side of the cabinet.




#### TO REMOVE AND REPLACE DRAWERS

TO REMOVE DRAWERS

Pull drawer out so it's almost fully extended. Push up one hand black release lever, while pushing down the other hand black release lever. While holding the levers in the positions as instructed above, pull the drawer outward until it is released from the drawer slide.



PUSH DOWN (THE OTHER HAND SIDE LEVER)



#### TO REPLACE DRAWERS

Extend the drawer slides from the tool chest/cabinet.

Insert the brackets on each side of the drawer into the slots in the chest/cabinet slides, being careful that they are positioned properly.

Once properly inserted, completely close the drawer to set the slides in their proper positions.


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#### RAISE AND RELEASE DRAWER FRONTS:

These units are equipped with the raise and release drawer fronts.


To open, lift up on the drawer front while pulling towards you. To close, shut the drawer firmly until the latch engages. If the drawer does not stay closed, the hook may be bent, or it may rub against the drawer slides.

To fix this problem, lightly bend the hook until the drawer will engage in the slide.




#### CHEST AND CABINET CONNECTION:

Place the chest on the cabinet; Attach the connectors and make sure the hook head snapping in the square hole on the back of the chest, then fasten the screws to the cabinet.




#### **Power Strip Cord (Chest)**

Open the lid and cut the band attaching the cord to the pegboard. Draw the cord and plug through the hole in the back of the chest as shown.



## **Power Strip Cord (Cabinet)**

Open the power tool drawer and cut the band attaching the cord to the pegboard. Push the cord and plug to the back of the drawer. Draw the cord and plug through the hole in the back of the cabinet as shown.




